

SAP Fiori revitalises frequently used ERP transactions with clean, modern user interfaces that can also be used on mobile devices.



Main benefits:

SAP Fiori, the new user experience featured in all new SAP solutions, is also already available for the most commonly used ERP transactions. Its intuitive user interfaces are designed to simplify day-to-day tasks on both workstations and mobile devices. Fiori is included in corresponding standard licences.

Thanks to SAP Fiori, users can utilise key SAP functions through a new and intuitive interface. This UX automatically adjusts to the device at hand, enabling employees to place orders, approve enquiries, request time off, and much more on their smartphones or tablets. Plus, the ability to access crucial information at all times and handle routine tasks while waiting or travelling on business will make them more productive. Your data will also be more up-to-date as a result, adding further business value to your SAP solutions.

Functional scope:

SAP Fiori also provides the option to access customers' back-end systems through SAP Mobile Platform. All of the data transferred is automatically encrypted without the need for a manual VPN connection. Any related authorisations are carried over and single sign-on is also supported. Depending on the scenario at hand, SAP Fiori can access the user's address book or camera. This makes it possible to call customers and scan and forward documents from within a given application. Push notifications display the next items on the user's to-do list, such as approval requests he or she has received.

SAP Fiori can be implemented in a modular format, meaning that a limited number of initial functions can be introduced with the new interface before proceeding with others later on. The interface's components are installed as add-ons. Meanwhile, the recommended separation of business back-end systems from the SAP Gateway front-end server ensures that changes and downtime can largely be avoided in the back-end systems. The design and modification of SAP Fiori applications takes place on the front-end server.
